Call for Proposals: 1st Singapore-Germany Academic-Industry International Collaboration. Deadline 29 March

Germany: International Climate Protection Fellowship for Young Climate Experts from Developing Countries. Deadline 1 March 2018



With the International Climate Protection Fellowships, the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation enables prospective leaders in academia and industry to implement a research-based proposal in the field of climate protection or climate-related resource conservation during a one-year stay in Germany. The monthly fellowship amount – depending on career stage – is €2,150 or €2,450 for fellows without a doctorate and €2,650 for postdoctoral researchers. Details [here](#)

TWAS USD 150,000 Prizes for Scientists from Developing Countries.



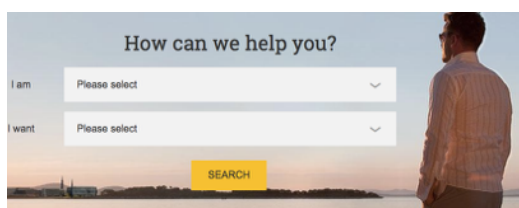
Every year The World Academy of Sciences, which is based in Trieste, Italy, awards nine prizes of USD15,000 each in the following fields: agricultural sciences; biology; chemistry; earth, astronomy and space sciences; engineering sciences; mathematics; medical sciences; physics and social sciences. Candidates for a TWAS Prize must be scientists who have been working and living in a developing country for at least ten years immediately prior to their nomination. Details [here](#)

United Kingdom: Wellcome Trust Doctoral Studentships. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 29 March 2018



This scheme enables researchers to undertake humanities or social science doctoral degrees in any area of health. You can apply for a Doctoral Studentship if you want to complete a period of research leading to a PhD in any humanities or social science area. You must have been accepted onto a PhD programme with an eligible host organisation in the UK, Republic of Ireland or a low- or middle-income country. You can be of any nationality.
